**ABF Questions**

1. What is your takeaway from the message?
2. Where do you see God at work in Chapters 7 and 8? Where do you see God at work in your life?
3. The Jews are in an impossible situation. How does God use Esther to change their situation? Any lessons for us today?
4. Esther 8:3-6 reveals Esther’s great burden for her people. Who do you have a burden for today? What is God asking you to do about your burden? Where is God asking you to be courageous by speaking up and showing up?
5. How might having a burden for someone apply to sharing the gospel with them? How does it apply to rescuing someone who has lost their way spiritually? Consider Galatians 6:1 and James 5:19-20
6. How convinced are you that God can use you in what seems to be an impossible situation? Are you available?
7. How do you generally respond to a crisis? Faith, fear, worry, inaction, with prayer, with action.
8. One person can really make a difference in the life of another person. What hinders us from getting involved in something hard or difficult that involves people?
9. What is something courageous God had you do on behalf of someone else? How did it turn out?
10. Have you ever had the privilege of celebrating with those who saw God work and turn around a situation that seemed impossible? Esther 8:15-17 Tell us about it.
