When the shepherd welcomes us to the table that He has prepared in the presence of our enemies, this encourages us to trust in His provisions.

You prepare a table before me
In the presence of my enemies
You anoint my head with oil, my cup overflows
Surely your goodness and love will follow me
And I will dwell in the house of the Lord
Forever

The Methodist minister Gaebelein suggest reading the psalm by asking, What do I lack?

Rest - for He makes me lie down in green pastures.

Peace - for He leads me beside still waters.

Forgiveness - for He restores my soul.

Guidance - for He leads me in righteous paths.

Companionship - for He is with me.

Comfort - for His rod and staff comfort me. Food - for He prepares a table for me.

Protection - for He does so in the presence of my enemies.

Acceptance - for He anoints my head with oil.

Abundance - for He makes my cup overflow.

Grace - for He makes goodness and mercy follow me.
Security - for He makes me dwell in His house forever.
