

A Life of Worship

Romans 12:1-8

“Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God’s mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship.”

Romans 12:1

Main Idea: The mercy of God calls us to live a life of worship through a transformation of the mind, humble devotion, and self-giving service.

All-in worship, all the time (v. 1)

- This is our response to God’s mercy, not a requirement to receive God’s mercy.

A renewed mind (v. 2)

- You can have a change of affection that rejects the world’s ways and reveals God’s best for your life.

Walking humbly with your God (v. 3)

- Acknowledging His presence in your life serves the discipline of humility.

We belong to each other in service (v. 4–8)

- We are all called to engage in the life of God’s family.
