

## **Where He Leads**

### **Psalm 23:2-3**

#### **A Psalm of David**

David declares he lacks nothing because, YHWH – the self-existent, eternal, is his shepherd, he goes into explanation of where the shepherd leads to provide for him.

#### **He makes me lie down in green pastures. (vs.2a)**

He makes me

Lie down in green pasture

-it is always available.

-it always satisfies.

-we need not worry. (*Matthew 6:25-27, 32-34*)

#### **He leads me beside quiet waters (vs.2b)**

Beside quiet waters

Jesus our Good Shepherd, offered “eternal waters.”

(*John 4:13-14*)

Jesus our Good Shepherd, offered calm or still waters.

(*Matthew 8:23-27; Mark 4:35-41; Luke 8:22-25*)

#### **He refreshes my soul.= (vs.3a)**

He restores my soul

#### **He guides me along the right paths for his name’s sake. (vs.3b)**

He guides me

The right paths (*Isaiah 40:8; Psalm 119:105*)

-God’s Word is the right path.

For His name sake

-it is all for His glory. (*Exodus 32:9-14*)
